## SELLING YOUR CAR AT AUCTION

### How do you put a car into auction?

*It's as easy as 1-2-3!*

1. Bring your car early on the day of auction – or better still, the day before. We can accept vehicles right up to 1pm on the day of the auction.

*Please note: only cars received before 1pm will be advertised in our auction catalogue and on our website. So the earlier, the better!*

2. Tell us your vehicle's registration number, your postcode and contact details. We'll give you an entry form, which you must check and sign.

3. Bring all car documents, NCT certificate, Log book, service history and additional keys, etc.

*Please note: only cars accompanied by a valid Log book can be accepted for sale.*

### How much does it cost?

The entry fee for cars, light commercials and motorcycles is €60.

When a car is sold, we will charge you 5% commission of the selling price (minimum €50) +VAT.

The entry fee and commission are paid out of the proceeds of your vehicle. For unsold items, the entry fee is charged after the auction to release your vehicle. Please bring this receipt with you as well as full photographic ID.

Unsold vehicles left on the premises without instruction will automatically be re-auctioned and the €60 entry fee will be applied each time.

All vehicles remaining on site more than seven days after being offered or left without instruction will be charged at a rate of €50 per vehicle per day storage fee.

### How should I set a reserve?

We can offer you a free valuation service to help set the reserve price for selling your vehicle, or to give you an idea how much your vehicle may fetch.

### When do I receive payment?

Payment for vehicles is made by cheque one week from the sale. Cheques can be collected during evening car auctions after 7pm. Please bring this receipt with you as well as full photographic ID. Uncollected cheques will be posted to your contact address.

### What do I do now?

Please keep this information leaflet as your receipt and quote your registration number in any query you may have.

- If you are attending the auction, it's best to try and arrive early. The auction starts at 7pm and is likely to end at any time between 9pm and 10.30pm. All vehicles are auctioned in lot number order as per the Auction catalogue which is available throughout the day on site and online.
- This catalogue information, which also appears online at [www.wilsonsauctions.com](http://www.wilsonsauctions.com), advertises your vehicle to potential purchasers.
- If you are not attending the auction, please leave us a suitable contact number as we may have to inform you of any 'provisional' bids. A provisional bid is a bid that has not equalled or exceeded your reserve but may be close to it. The auctioneer will then call you to negotiate an agreed price.
- If we haven't contacted you, give us a call the following day to find out the status of your vehicle. Remember, vehicles left without instruction will automatically be re-entered into the next auction. If your car is unsold the car department can advise you on the best course of action; for example amending the reserve price or enhancing your vehicles appearance with our on-site valeting and refurbishment services.

### Do we have your correct contact telephone number and address?

It's important that we have the following:

- a contact telephone number  
*to let you know of any provisional bids*
- your postal address  
*for posting out your payment*

You will be asked to check these details on your entry form. Please do so carefully.
